## RHB 'records' highest single property return!

Board sells property at nine times the listed price

from Jaipur: Going strength to strength, Rajasthan Housing Board (RHB) has yet again proved that better management can help to economic overcome slump and financial woes brought by the Corona pandemic. This was evident on Wednesday when the RHB sold off a nine square meter shop in Madhuban Scheme at Jodhpur at nine times its listed price! The list price for the shop was Rs 6.75 lakh, however, it was sold off for Rs 49 lakh! Similarly, another 9 sq mt shop in the same scheme, with a list price of Rs 6.30 lakh, was sold off for Rs 17.33 lakh je

two and a half times the list price. On this Wednesday, the RHB sold a total of 286 properties generating a revenue of Rs 41 crore.

"People were excited to take part in the 'Apni Dukaan - Apna Vyavsaay' scheme of the RHB. On the first Wednesday of this scheme total 185 commercial properties were sold generating 26.57 crore rupees in revenue. Moreover, 101 resi-

dential properties under the Wednesday Auction were also sold off which brought another 14.25 crore rupees in revenue to the RHB's kitty," said Pawan Arora, Commissioner, RHB.

Launched by CM Gehlot a week back, the scheme has sold off properties worth 27 crore rupees in its first week and therefore it is already a success on its first day!
