

Success Stories in Medical & Health Sector

In consideration to increasing requirement of additional infrastructural facilities in medical sector and problems faced by patients; in the year 2002 Hon'ble Chief Minister desired inclusion of medical facilities in the project cities of Phase I. Accordingly request was made by Govt. of Rajasthan before Deptt. Of Economic Affairs Govt. of India & Asian Development Bank, for its approval. After approval of ADB on 28.10.2002, RUIDP formulated 10 packages in RUIDP phase I towns for up gradation of facilities in medical sector. The works to be taken up were initially identified by having meetings with medical authorities of all project cities. These works were reviewed and finalized in the meetings held on 30.6.2003 in the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister M&H.

Works for following hospitals in 3 towns Jaipur, Kota, Ajmer and Udaipur were sanctioned and have been completed by RUIDP as per details given as under:

JAIPUR

- **S.M.S.Hospital**

There was problem of overcrowding in outdoors of old building of SMS hospital. Outdoors of various departments such as medicine, surgery, cardiology, cardio surgery, neurology, neurosurgery, chest & allergy, orthopedics, blood/urine collection centre, radiology lab etc. were located at staggered locations in old building. This was putting patients in great trouble besides loss of time and they had to move around several places even for interdepartmental counseling. Similarly there was shortage of operation theatres in old building of SMS hospital and there was long waiting list for pending operations. RUIDP constructed New OPD & OT building and allied works of campus development in SMS Hospital, Jaipur. This building comprises of 2 storey underground parking and 3 floors out of which 2 floors are for outdoor patients while one floor is for operation theatres. There are 12 operation theatres out of which five are modular one and seven are non modular. Operation theatre floor is completely air conditioned while outdoor floors are centrally air cooled. Besides, there has been a comfortable ambience for the patients with large patient's air cooled waiting space. At present new 3 storied building is benefitting approximately 3500 outdoor patients while average 40 operations are conducted in operation theatres. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 20.70 Crores.

- **J.K.Lone Children Hospital**

There was problem of overcrowding in outdoors, indoor wards and operation theatres of old building of J.K.Lone hospital. Children used to face lot of inconvenience and there was long waiting list for operations and indoor patients. Construction of new building has facilitated outdoor patients with dedicated floor having all facilities including waiting space. The ward is 100 bedded and this has provided great comfort to the patients. Similarly 4 no. operation theatres have reduced waiting list of operations. An average of 25 operations is conducted after construction of new operation theatres. Construction cost of work was Rs. 5.73 Crores.

- **Mahila Chikitsalaya, Sanganeri Gate**

In Mahila Chikitsalaya there was also same problem of overcrowding in outdoors, indoor wards and facility of common toilets for women in particular. RUIDP constructed outdoor portion which has facilitated the patients as well as their wards. There was long waiting list of indoor patients and after construction of new indoor wards capacity of wards has been increased by ----. Apart from it, new Sulabh complex has been constructed along with laundry and kitchen. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 4.62 Crores.

- **Zanana Hospital**

In Zanana Hospital 2 wards, one each for oncology and neo natal were constructed to facilitate treatment of the cancer patients and newly born children. Apart from it cottage rooms, conference hall, laundry and kitchen were also constructed for patients and doctors. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 2.52 Crores.

- **T.B. and Chest Hospital**

There were lack of emergency facilities in TB hospital and patients were facing problems. RUIDP made interventions and constructed Intensive Care Unit (ICU), outdoor registration counter, laundry and water reservoir. Construction cost of work was Rs. 1.21 Crores.

KOTA

- **Up-gradation of Facilities in Medical Collage**

There was large gap in facilities in the medical college hospital. RUIDP constructed 18 operation theatres with air conditioning, medical gas and lighting arrangements. In addition to it blood bank, 5 wards with 170 beds were also constructed. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 8.50 Crores.

- **Satellite Hospital**

Looking to overcrowding and pressure on main hospital of Kota, one hospital was need of the hour in the walled city. Satellite hospital has been constructed in Rampura area of Kota. Average 200-300 outdoor patients are benefitted from this satellite hospital and this has added to improvement in specialized services in main hospital. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 1.60 Crores.

- **Renovation of different Dispensaries in Kota**

There are 8 dispensaries in Kota city. These were old buildings and patients were facing inconvenience due to uncovered space. Renovation work was taken up in 8 dispensaries namely- Dadabari, Talwandi, Mahavir Nagar, Shopping centre, Kunhadi, Sakatpura, Bhimganjmandi, Govind Nagar. After this renovation work there has been considerable change in the ambience and facility to the patients. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 1.58 Crores.

AJMER

- **Satellite Hospital**

Satellite hospital was constructed in Adarsh Nagar of Ajmer to provide medical facility to residents of outer colonies. This provided facility of specialists to outdoor patients as well as indoor patients with 50 bed occupation capacity. Presently 250 outdoor patients utilize this hospital. This has provided facility to outer colonies besides reducing the load on medical college hospital. This hospital is also being used by administration for mobile medical unit. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 2.71 Crores.

UDAIPUR

- **Expansion & Rehabilitation of hospital buildings and Development of Infrastructure in M.B.Hospital**

There was overcrowding in Zanana outdoor of M.B.hospital, thereby putting women patients to great inconvenience. Certain areas like blood bank, urology deptt. Were also deficit of infrastructural facilities. RUIDP constructed Zanana outdoor block, blood bank, modification work in urology deptt. for better facility to dialysis patients, kitchen, laundry and mortuary. Construction cost of the work was Rs. 2.55 Crores.
