

FAQs For AIS Residency Phase III

1. Who can apply under AIS Phase III?

Applicants belonging to the All India Services (IAS, IPS, IFS) serving in the Rajasthan cadre are eligible to apply under AIS Phase III.

2. What income groups are available in AIS Residency Phase III?

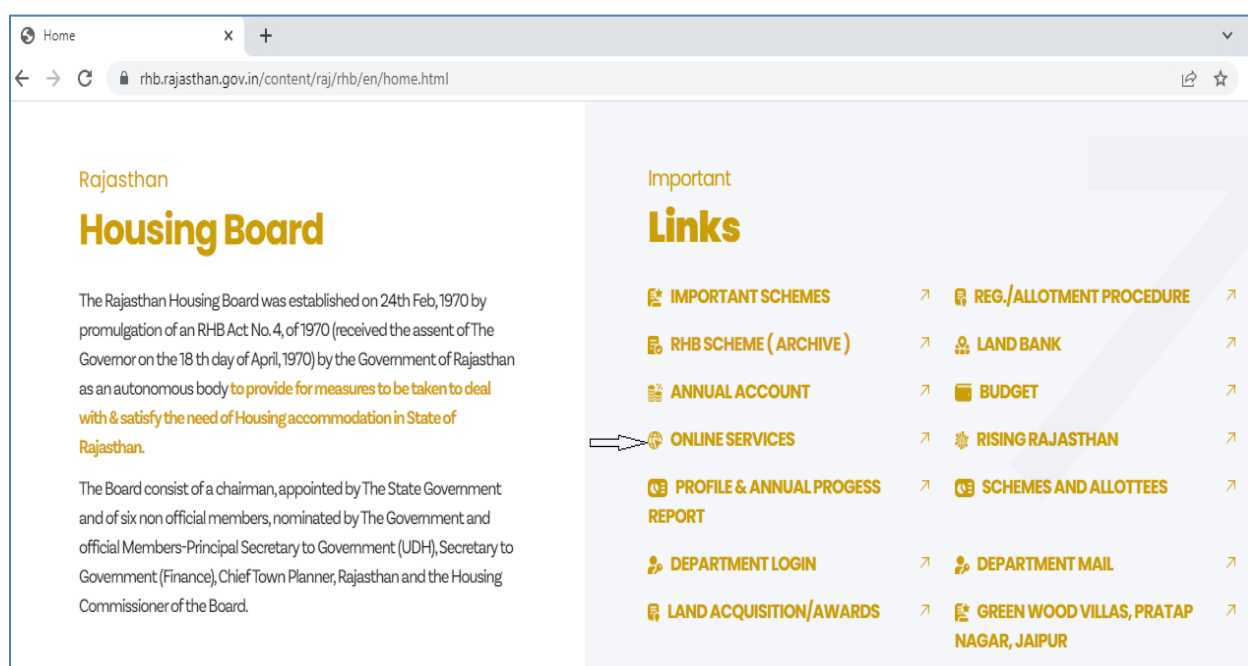
Two types of properties are available under AIS Residency Phase III: HIG-I and HIG-II.

3. How can I register for the Residential Housing Scheme in AIS Residency Phase III?

4. What documents are required for registration in AIS Residency Phase III?

Following documents are required to fill the application form

- Photo of the Applicant
- Sign of the Applicant
- Photo of the Co-Applicant (If Any)
- Photo ID Proof
- Adhar Card (Details Only)
- Adhar Card Co-Applicant (Details Only)
- Pan Card (Details Only)
- Nominee Details

5. What is the last date to submit the application?

The last date for submission of the application will be announced on the official RHB website, mentioned in the scheme booklet, and displayed in the Citizen Login section of the RHBMS portal.

6. How will applicants be selected?

Applicants may be selected through an online lottery process, as specified in the scheme guidelines.

7. Can I modify my application after submission in AIS Residency Phase III?

Limited modifications may be allowed before the closing date and after publication of the temporary list. Only changes that do not affect the scheme fees and category are permitted, such as date of birth, income details, nominee name, etc.

8. How can I check the status of my application?

Applicants can check their application status online through the official RHB website and the RHBMS portal.
